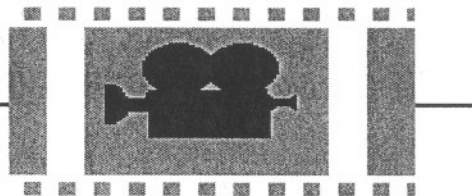

What is Film Club?

Naperville Central's **Film Club** is a voluntary extra-curricular activity that meets on Thursdays after school in room 20-F in the LRC. The club serves two main functions:

- provide a place for students who love movies to meet, watch them together and discuss them
- facilitate and assist students who want to experiment with video production and movie-making

Who can join Film Club?

Film Club is open to all Central students, but students under the age of 17 **MUST** have a signed permission slip from a parent to allow for the viewing of R-rated material during meetings.

What happens at meetings?

Weekly meetings will begin at 3:20 with about ten minutes of announcements and discussions. Films begin at 3:30 every Thursday and the meetings run as long as that week's film plus a few weeks extra for discussion. Because this is a fun, social club, attendance is not mandatory and you may come and go as you please. We only ask that you try not to be disruptive during viewing (talking on cell phones, walking in and out of the room, distracting if you leave early, etc.). Students who are involved in actual film production work will gather as soon as the film viewing begins to discuss and complete work and are welcome to join the viewing at their leisure.

Does Film Club do anything else?

YES! We arrange a trip to the Chicago International Film Festival, which runs this year from October 5-19 in downtown Chicago (see chicagofilmfestival.org for more info). Also, we have an Oscar party in February and host a school-wide Student Film Festival as our club fundraiser in May.
